

Our goal here at this preschool is that the children feel as comfortable as humanly possible. But to achieve that they need comfortable clothes that are warm, dry and do not restrict them during playtime.

Outdoor clothes need to be comfortable as well, preferably so that the child can easily dress themselves.

In Iceland we have all kinds of weather, and the child needs to have appropriate clothes each time.

Children play during school time. They do crafts, eat, wash their hands and play outside. During those times their clothes can get wet or dirty. That is why it's important that the child has extra clothes. There is a special box for their extra clothes in their cubby and that is why we do not want bags taking up room.

Here is a list of what we think is important to have at school or in that special box.

Remember to label all clothes with the child's name because there are over 90 children in the school, and we can't possibly remember who owns what.

For older kids. 3-5 year old (the bare minimum)

Outdoor clothes

- A raincoat and pants or suit
- A snow suit (not during summer)
- A warm sweater
- A warm hat and a thin one as well.
- Warm socks (not during summer)
- 2-3 pairs of mittens (not during summer)
- Warm snowshoes (Not during summer)
- Boots
- Light shoes

Extra clothes

- 2 pairs of underwear/onesie
- 2 singlets/onesie
- 2 pairs of socks/tights
- 1 pair of pants
- 1 T-shirt

- 1 sweater

Younger children, 2-3 year old (the bare minimum)

Outdoor clothes

- A raincoat and pants or suit
- A snow suit (not during summer)
- A warm sweater
- A warm hat and a thin one as well.
- Warm socks (not during summer)
- 2-3 pairs of mittens (not during summer)
- Warm snowshoes (Not during summer)
- Boots
- Light shoes

Extra clothes

- 3 pairs of underwear/onesie
- 2 singlets/onesie
- 3 pairs of socks/tights
- 3 pair of pants
- 1 T-shirt
- 1 sweater

You need to watch what is used from the box, take home wet/dirty clothes and replace what is used.

The clothes in the boxes always stay at school but the clothes in the cubby need to go home every Friday.

We hope we can work as a team so that your child always has comfortable, dry and clean clothes at school.
